The exceptional location, the quality of the rehabilitation, the perfectly maintained bourgeois condominium and the proximity to all amenities are undeniably the major assets of this property. 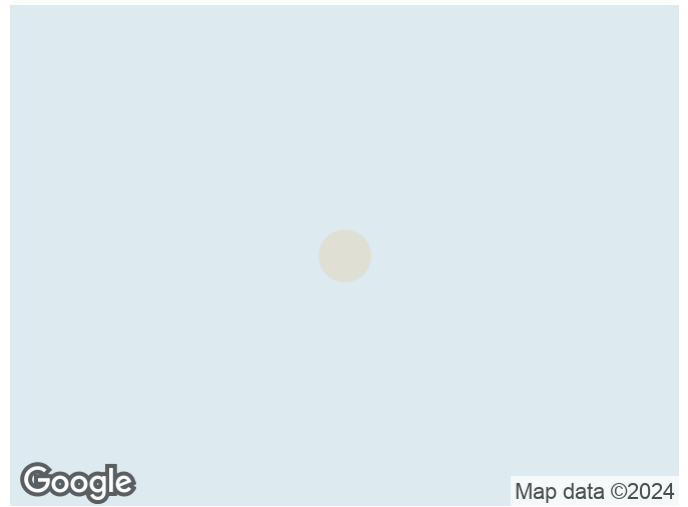
