A flight of steps leads to the upper floor. Here, kitchen, dining room and living room come together to form a

warm 49m2 unit opening onto a large balcony with a clear view. The exposed framework and the wood stove bring character and warmth to this renovation enhanced by a polished concrete floor. Adjoining this space, two bedrooms of 11m2 and 14m2 share a bathroom.

Through the half-landing between the ground floor and the 1st floor, future guests could have access to a future terrace.
