A former Napoleonic farmhouse, rebuilt and renovated, Chalet Gueret is a very well built and well appointed property with an attractive traditional style and high quality finish throughout the living areas and bedrooms. With 8 bedrooms and 7 bathrooms, it can easily accommodate a large family and friends. The ground floor comprises a two-bedroom flat with its own living room and separate entrance.
