
On the heights of the charming village of Pollionnay, this old 1820 farm of 340m2 was masterfully renovated by an architect in 2011 and benefits from an exceptional panoramic view of Lyon and the Alps. Like a "hacienda", this magnificent rehabilitation is organized around a central courtyard with trees and its fountain. In a very contemporary style, the main body of this old farm accommodates on the ground floor, a separate equipped kitchen and a large double living room with access to a terrace overlooking the garden and enjoying a breathtaking view. A flight of steps leads to a half level where there is a laundry area. Continuing on, the staircase serves the upper floor and its night area which includes two beautiful bedrooms, a bathroom, an office space and a spacious master suite decorated with three dressing rooms and a bathroom with shower. On the lower level, a fully equipped cinema room and a games room are located. Facing the main building, a 6m x 3.20m indoor swimming pool opens onto a 20sqm suspended terrace. A gym completes this exceptional property. Family gatherings will take place in the old barn, which houses a magnificent summer kitchen with an ethanol fireplace and a large 40sqm mezzanine.
