Located on Place Bellecour, in the heart of the second arrondissement of Lyon, this 226.15sqm Carrez apartment with balconies is located on the 3rd floor with elevator of a very beautiful bourgeois building, perfectly maintained. Here, all the markers of the old, such as the period parquet floors, the fireplaces, the Lyonnaise cupboards as well as the beautiful high ceilings have been carefully preserved, thus giving the
