The main entrance opens onto a large room facing east and west. A bright room with windows to the east and sliding doors to the west opening onto the terrace along the Cosanne. The French beamed ceiling is 3 meters

high, providing a beautiful volume. The comfort of this room is a combination of old and new: underfloor heating with modern tiling, a recent wood stove installed in an old stone and brick fireplace, a wrought iron railing, and some exposed stones. The dining area opens onto a modern kitchen equipped with light cream colour that blends well with the old hexagonal terra cota tiles, the oak and wrought iron staircase, and the stone window jambs. From the kitchen, you access a shower room with a separate toilet, which has just been renovated, as well as the heated veranda. It naturally opens onto the courtyard where you can enjoy an outdoor space with numerous flowers, bushes, and a small tree. A gate leads to the parking space in front of the barn. The veranda also serves as a daily entrance. A small cloakroom allows for storing shoes and coats. The door leading to the street is a security door. From the kitchen, you go up to the mezzanine, which serves as a library and office, with a small balcony overlooking the street. This space opens onto a large master bedroom with built-in closets and a desk area that can be used as a studio, dressing room, or reading nook. A spacious bathroom with a corner bathtub and toilet completes this master suite. From the mezzanine, you access the second bedroom with a view of the Cosanne, as well as a staircase leading to the second level with a third bedroom under the eaves. In the basement, there is a small heated blind office, a large laundry room with a heating system corner, a pantry area, a cellar/wood storage, and a wine cellar. You can exit onto the street from the cellar by going up a few steps. The barn is very spacious with a floor height allowing for parking a camper with a car or 3 cars. In one corner is the workshop of the "station master"! This property is ideal for a second home with a large enough outdoor space to enjoy summer periods without having to spend weekends gardening! The village of Vauchignon offers numerous walks in the woods and towards the cliffs, the waterfall, the source of the Cosanne, and is close to Nolay with all its amenities, medical center, and schools...
