Here you have a practical utility room, a door to the attic (suitable for conversion) and a door to the former potter's kiln room. Further down the hallway there is the master bedroom and a fully renovated bathroom. In the bathroom you will find a shower, wash handbasin and a large storage cabinet. It is possible to install a bath in this bathroom, the plumbing and drainage are already in place. Behind the cabinet all the plumbing is in place to put in a bath if you would fancy one. The cellar (former potter's kiln room) can be accessed from the inside of the house and from the outside. There is also an adjoining garage with workshop. The house has double glazing throughout and is in perfect condition. The house is mainly heated by a large wood-burning stove that redistributes the heat and recent electric radiators. The house is equipped with fibre optic internet access. The house can be sold furnished. There is also adjoining studio flat. This flat has a separate access by an outside staircase. On the first floor, bright attic living room, bedroom and shower room with wc, possibility to place a kitchenette. This independent studio is ideal for welcoming guests or for renting out, The village has a nursery and primary school, a restaurant, a mini-market with a bread depot. Close to Château de Ratilly, Saint Amand en Puisaye, Guedelon.
