# **Property Description**

Located in a quiet village on the edge of the forest near Villers-Cotterêts, this charming single-storey habitable property offering approximately 300 sq.m of living area built in stone and covered in slate is set on fully enclosed plot of land of approximately 5,400 sq.m.

Pass through the entrance to this property and discover on the ground floor a beautiful living room of 55 sq.m.

composed of a living room with access to the terrace and a dining room. Installing a stove in the living room is made possible thanks to the presence of a chimney flue. You will also benefit from a separate and fitted kitchen, two bedrooms, an office, a bathroom and a shower room with WC.

The *first floor* offers two separate living spaces, each with its own access. The first part will provide you with a living room with a magnificent freestone fireplace as well as a master suite with bathroom and WC. The *second* part is made up of two bedrooms, a bathroom and a separate toilet.

In the *basement*, you will discover a surface area of 60 sq.m converted into a living room and laundry area. This level has a large window to the outside and independent access. A garage, a workshop, an outbuilding decorate this property.

The landscaped garden is easy to maintain thanks to its installation for a robot lawn mower. This property has benefited from regular work and maintenance. The individual sanitation system is compliant.

The town has a school cluster and a transport service for the Middle and High School. Villers Cotterêts is less than 10 minutes away (all shops and services), Pierrefonds is 15 minutes away. Paris is 75 km away (50 minutes by train from Villers-Cotterêts) and Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport is 40 minutes away.
