Property Description

Located in the heart of the Périgord Noir in the Vézère valley, just 5 minutes from the famous pre-historic Lascaux caves, this charming mansion boasts a large roof and many authentic elements. Situated in a hamlet with a clear view, the property consists of a main residence with a swimming pool and a separate 45 sqm apartment with independent access, ideal for seasonal rental.

The 190 sqm main house features a spacious living room (60 sqm) with a fireplace, stone walls, an adobe floor, an old vegetable garden, a stone sink, and an open kitchen. Additionally, it includes a second living room with an insert, an old soiled and stone sink, a bedroom, a full bathroom (shower and bath), a dressing room, and possible access to a mezzanine. On the upper level, there are two large bedrooms and a generous landing, offering the potential for a bathroom installation. The property offers modern comforts including geothermal heating, good insulation (DPE in C), and a connection to the main sewer system.

The separate two-level apartment comprises a living room with kitchenette, two bedrooms, and a bathroom, with the added bonus of a heated pool. Adjoining outbuildings include a boiler room, a laundry room, and a 25 sqm barn on two levels.
