

A stone's throw from the iconic Rue Notre Dame, this stone house is located on the second line of a small condominium, offering a country feel in the heart of the city.

Access to the house is via the terraced and planted garden of 60m2. A beautiful exterior stone staircase gives access to the living area, composed of a living room and a kitchen-dining room, separated by a functional fireplace. Contemporary materials combine elegantly with the preserved charm of the old.

A separate office completes this level. A first sleeping area located on the garden level is made up of two large bedrooms with dressing rooms, a bathroom, a laundry room and storage space. A second sleeping area upstairs offers a second bathroom, two bedrooms and an office space.




