Property Description

This old priory is located near all amenities and is just 10 minutes from Périgueux. It offers a spacious indoor and outdoor living area. The building's character and authenticity have been well preserved. It has approximately 320 sqm of living space spread over 2 levels and is surrounded by an enclosed park of about 5600 sqm.

On the ground floor, there is a large living room (66 sqm) and a sitting room (42 sqm) with impressive fireplaces, exposed beams, and stonework, with each room overlooking the garden. Additionally, there is an old kitchen, a bedroom, and a bathroom on the same level. Two staircases at each end of the house provide access to the upper level. The upper floor features another large living room (70 sqm), two bedrooms (which are also accessible from the outside), a bathroom, and a mezzanine. In addition, there are extra spaces such as an old orangery, a stone cellar, a garage, and an attic.

The park is beautifully landscaped and features majestic mature trees (some of which are listed). There is also a carp pond fed by a stream and an old aviary within the grounds.


