Property Description

Located near Rouffignac and close to many renowned tourist sites, this Country House with outbuildings is on a plot of about 8700 sqm and provides a remarkable living environment.

The main house offers a living area of about 109 sqm. The ground floor comprises a complete living space, including a family kitchen, a living room with a pellet stove, a bedroom, a bathroom with an Italian shower, and an office. Additionally, a veranda serves as a complementary living space. A wooden staircase leads to

the attic, which has been converted into 2 bedrooms, a bathroom, and a toilet.

A spacious barn, part of which can be renovated into a house (100 sqm on the ground + 100 sqm on the floor), offers great potential. A preliminary project for this purpose has already been carried out. Other outbuildings include 2 cellars of 25 sqm each (with concrete floor and clay floor) and a 66 sqm shed/garage.

The flat and raised ground is adorned with numerous fruit trees and a rainwater-fed pond, offering the potential to create various outdoor spaces such as play areas, a vegetable garden, animal enclosures, and even a swimming pool. Additionally, a 4000L tank collects rainwater with a pump. The sanitation system is nearly complete, with only secondary ventilation needing to be added.




