Property Description

Located in the beautiful Périgord Vert, this character house is just 5 minutes away from one of the most beautiful villages of France and 10 minutes from Thiviers. The property offers a unique living environment with peaceful surroundings, natural beauty, and the typical character of Périgord.

This former mill house has been renovated and offers approximately 225 sqm of living space. The property includes charming living rooms with exposed beams and fireplaces on each level, an American kitchen, four spacious bedrooms, and two bathrooms. It is equipped with modern amenities such as fibre connectivity, good insulation, double glazing, compliance with electricity and sanitation standards, and a favourable DPE rating for an old building (C). Additionally, it features outbuildings including a 95 sqm barn attached to the main house and a carport.

Outside, the property sits on 3.6 hectares of land, partly covered with woods and grassland. A river traverses the land on over approximately 300m, providing an exceptional and rare setting in the Dordogne region.

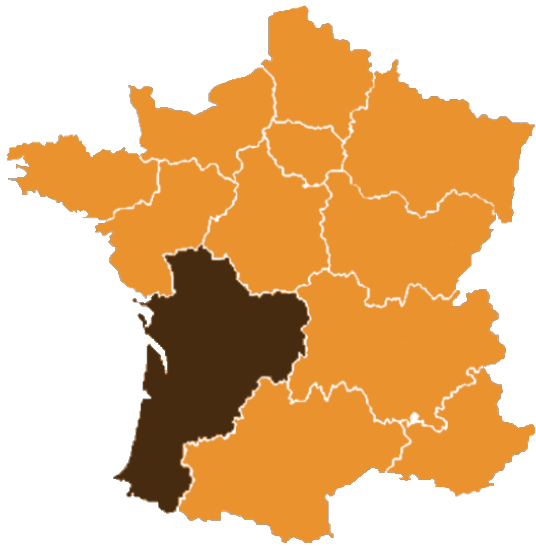

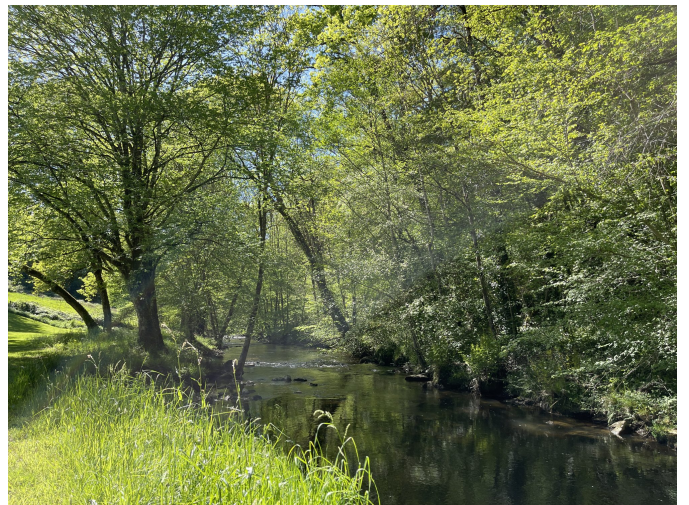

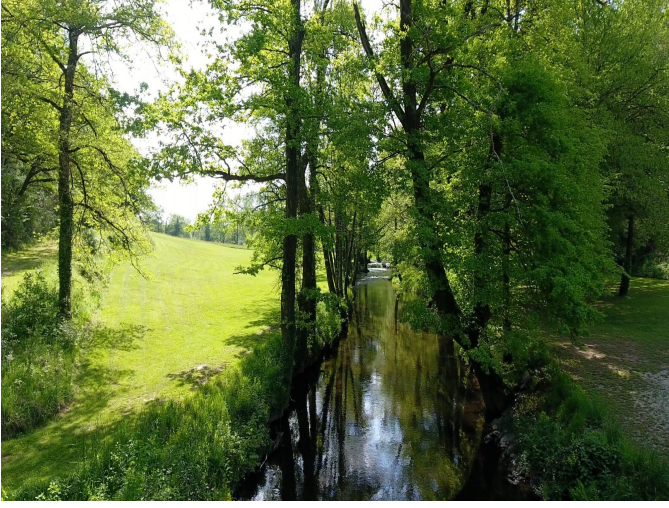
