It offers 260 sqm of living space on a 500 sqm plot including a 120 sqm terrace and an infinity pool. Built on two levels and on a planted plot, the house, clad in Corten metal with a strong style, has had a facelift and benefits from an extension with a roof

terrace.

On the ground floor, an entrance with storage leads to a first bedroom equipped with a dressing room and a bathroom. 

















