

Ideally located 20 minutes south of Agen, this beautiful 12th-century Castle boasts large outbuildings, stunning views of the countryside and the Pyrenees, and 11 hectares of parkland, meadows, woods and a spring.

A large stone arch forms the entrance to the castle courtyard and its adjoining outbuildings. The living area of 533 m² is divided between the main castle and an adjoining apartment. The tower and the large outbuildings, totaling over 400 m² on the ground floor, complement the main structure. The roofs are in good condition, but the entire property requires renovation to restore it to its former glory.

Originally an agricultural estate, the property includes additional large outbuildings. A charming dovecote, in urgent need of attention, completes the buildings.
