It has several outbuildings such as a garage of 95 m², an original stable and a workshop, each of 28 m², a garage converted into a workshop of 22 m² and a garden storage room of 16

m². In addition, a pleasant easy to maintain garden of 200 m² with 2 pretty ponds, a well and a courtyard of 100 m².

The property has entrances on 3 different streets so it could be divided into several independant dwellings (gite, guest house) if desired.

Its 554 m² are divided into several reception rooms such as 2 large living rooms, a sitting room, a dining room, a summer lounge, a large fully equipped kitchen with granit countertops and a range cooker, an office, 5 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms. Two of the bedrooms have their en-suite, the master bedroom also has its en-suite dressing room.

Some of the living rooms could be turned into additional bedrooms if required. The superb library benefits from a home cinema. And for wine lovers there is an amazing wine cellar with air conditioning and gravel flooring. This property has everything you are looking for: beauty, comfort, quality and privacy.

It has been completely renovated by the current owners in 2009 who have instructed a very good architect to carry out all of the work.
