The home allies the confort of a town gas central heating and the original character of the 19th century, with 4 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms (including 3 en suite). Located in the heart of the village, just steps away from all shops. Sold furnished.

Ground = Entrance hall of 15 m² open onto a living room of 37 m² wood burner and access to the terrace + equipped kitchen of 15 m² (upper and lower units, hob, electric oven, dishwasher and fridge, extrator fan, sink) with utility area and access to the terrace + lounge/office of 16.5 m² + wc with handbasin.
