Property Description

Located just a few kilometers from Lectoure with its shops, markets, schools, and thermal baths, this beautiful countryside property boasts views of the valleys, an 8500 m² garden, and a pleasant swimming pool.

The Gascon-style house, of 309 m², opens onto a large terracotta-tiled entrance hall, which leads to a living room with an insert fireplace, a kitchen opening onto the garden, a dining room, and a large suite comprising a bedroom, an office, a bathroom, a dressing room, a toilet, and a laundry room. The ground floor has access to an adjoining outbuilding of 50 m² which can expand the house's living space.

Upstairs, the spacious landing with exposed beams currently serves as a reading corner and a home cinema. It leads to 3 bedrooms, a bathroom, and a toilet. It also provides access to a 92 m² space to be converted, with stairs leading to the ground floor outbuilding. These two areas can therefore be independent of the main house (storage, guest accommodation, bed and breakfast, professional office, etc.), or increase the habitable space.

The house has retained beautiful features such as cupboards, woodwork, floors, and fireplaces.

The garden, enhanced by its trees and flowers, features a saltwater heated swimming pool, lovely views of the countryside, and a magnificent 150 m² covered terrace with white stone walls.

An enjoyable countryside property without being completely isolated, close to Lectoure.
