The meticulous landscaping around the swimming pool includes a pool house with fitted kitchen, covered terrace, barbecue and pizza oven, jacuzzi and shower. Numerous outbuildings, used as a reception room, garage and storage area, and even including three horse stalls with water and electricity, complete this exceptional property. 


