This former 330sqm hunting lodge dating from 1881 perfectly combines the charm of the old with the contemporary on a prime location in Tournefeuille. Beyond the gate, the unique architecture of this property of character and the different stages of construction are gradually revealed. As soon as you enter, the volumes are striking. On the right wing, a modern kitchen is naturally extended by a dining room. The living room is

An architect intervened in the extension of the original building. A glass walkway provides access to the secondary lounge used as a projection room. 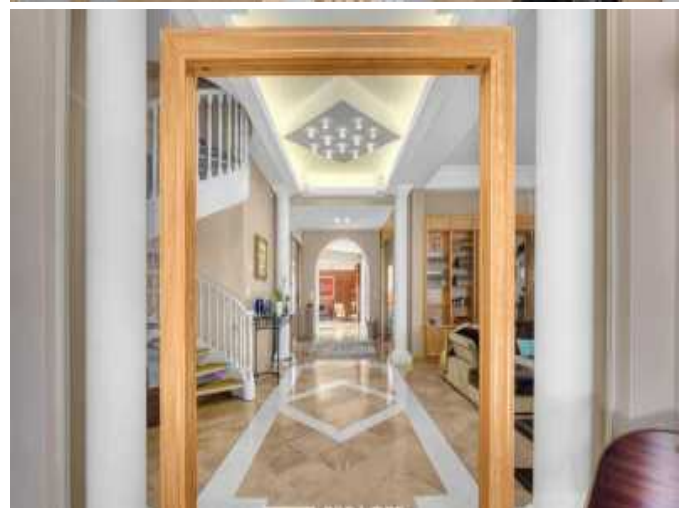
