Property Description

This remarkable and unique property consists of a beautifully preserved 19th-century chateau that has been recently renovated throughout. It also features a garage for your vehicles, a park with a splendid swimming pool and complete privacy, a stone building with four renovated independent apartments that are currently

rented out, and three large stone and wood-framed hangars for all your agricultural equipment. The hangars are in good condition.

The property spans 121 hectares and is contiguous. It comprises 70 hectares of AOP vineyards, 19 hectares of fields (including 5 hectares located adjacent to the park and one of the hangars, suitable for horses), and 32 hectares of woodland with various tree species. The estate currently produces AOP "Malepère" wine and is a tranquil sanctuary nestled in the foothills of the Malepère region. Additionally, all the necessary agricultural equipment for managing the vineyard is available for purchase as an option for approximately €600,000. The château holds fantastic potential for further development.
