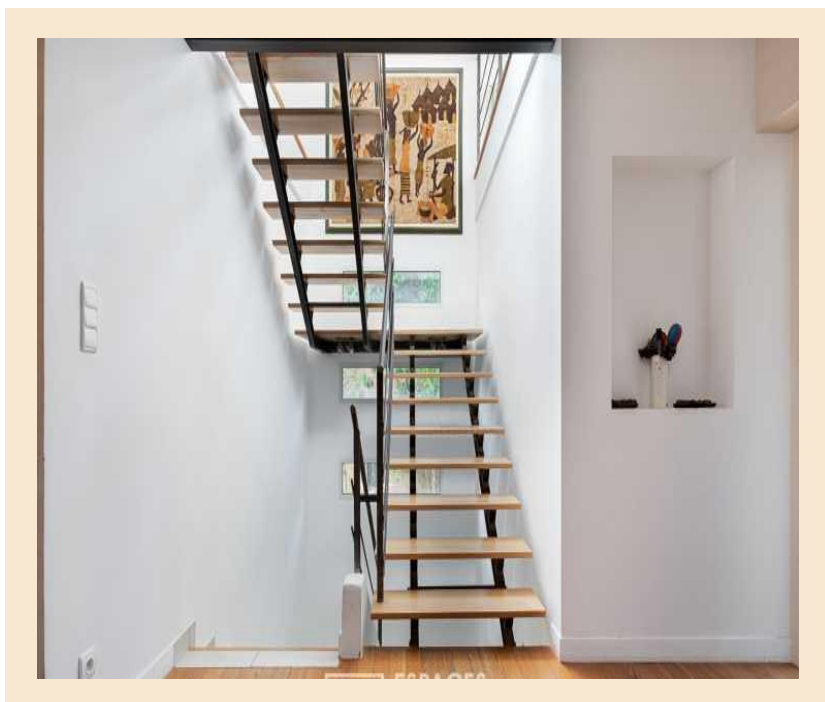

Located on Côte Pavée, a few minutes from the city center, this family house covers approximately 230sqm. In addition to the main building, it offers a 70sqm chartreuse. Everything is located on a plot of almost 650sqm. Beyond the gate, the unique architecture of the main house is revealed. An elevation took place a few years ago in order to provide a larger surface area. From the entrance, the perspective opens onto the living room, through and bathed in light. A kitchen naturally extends this space. Back at the entrance, the staircase, the true backbone of the house, serves the two other levels dedicated to rest. On the first floor, 4

bedrooms are available, one of which is 23sqm opening onto a balcony. They have two bathrooms. The 55sqm master suite has direct access to a 22sqm terrace and a view of the garden. The exterior is not left out, a large terrace opening onto the living room promises good times with friends or family. The garden is an extension. The chartreuse has been transformed into 2 apartments with a strong rental income. Everything can be divided, the plot division has already been carried out by the owners. This house has benefited from a contemporary renovation mixed with original materials from the 70s.
