Old stone barn dating from the 19th century (1883) totally converted, with a living space of 178 m2 offering

a magnificent living room of 70 m² with stunning high ceilings of more than 3m (lounge, dining and opened kitchen), 3 bedrooms (one is a master), 2 bath/shower rooms, an office (or extra bedroom), a pleasant courtyard of 20 m² plus a roof terrace of 21 m² with a breathtaking panoramic view. Full of character ! In a peaceful area !

Ground = Entrance of 11.88 m² with cupboard + WC with wash hand basin of 1.76 m² + beautiful living room of 70 m² with a stunning high ceiling of more than 3m, nice cosy lounge with a wood burning stove, dining room with open kitchen (working plan, double sink, gas piano cooker, hood) leading on beautiful charming courtyard of 20 m² with a water fall fountain.

1st = Hall of 8 m² with cupboard + WC of 1.67 m² with wash hand basin unit + bathroom of 6.09 m² (bath, basin unit, towel dryer).

1/2 floor (a few steps) = Hall of 3.41 m² + master bedroom of 16 m² with bedroom and en suite shower room (shower, sink) plus cupboard with hot water tank and tumble dryer + bedroom of 13.81 m² (large cupboard and nice view on church) + spacious bedroom of 24 m² (sink) and large cupboard that could be converted into shower room.

Exteriors = A beautiful private courtyard of 20 m² with a waterfall fountain + magnificent roof terrace of 21 m² (semi-covered) offering a panoramic breathtaking view (authentic mix with view on the 12th century church on one side and view on the Pyrenees on the other) with nice summer kitchen (working plan, fridge, micro wave), giving the possibility of enjoying sun and shade.
