## **Property Description**

Located 10 mins north of Tarbes is this 101m<sup>2</sup> bungalow dating from 2008 (2005 building regulations) with underfloor heating. There is a spacious living space with central fireplace and big windows, three bedrooms, two bathrooms and a superb Japanese garden which will appeal to many families.

This charming property has an automated entrance gate, pretty trees and a superb japonaise garden with pond and waterfall. The house has a 45m<sup>2</sup> living area including the hall, kitchen, dining and sitting room where sits

a splendid and modern central fireplace. Two distinct patio doors leads to the terrace and a 12m<sup>2</sup> conservatory, the latter which has two patio doors leading to the Japanese garden with pond, complete with water lilies and waterfall.

A passageway from the living room leads to three bedrooms. The first (10m²) had a storage cupboard and patio door leading outside. The second bedroom (11m²) has its own washroom with sink. The third bedroom, the master suite, has a 10m² bedroom, 4m² walk-in wardrobe and a 5m² washroom with sink and large shower. It is heated by an Acova towel-dryer radiator. A passageway has a 1.4m² toilet with sink.

A 15m<sup>2</sup> storage space, previously used as a garage, is accessed from the kitchen. There is a 7.5m<sup>2</sup> larder with its own hot water tank.

The garage's automated roller shutter could easily be replaced by a window and the interior transformed to an independent studio. A door from the larder leads directly to the garden.

Back outside and the vast courtyard can house several vehicles. The garden has a fenced section should you wish to keep some animals.

This quality home has been well maintained since its construction.

The roof is covered in tile with a truss framework. Windows are aluminium and PVC framed with double glazing and roller shutters of which some are automated. There is electric powered underfloor heating. There is a central fireplace. The house is connected to the sewage mains. The garden has a sink hole for channeling rainwater.

You will be 10 mins north of Tarbes, 20 mins from Tarbes-Lourdes-Pyrenees airport, 1h30 from the Atlantic Ocean, 3h from the Mediterranean and 1h from nearest skiing.


