Close to Lectoure, set on 2.2 hectares of garden and land, this typical Gascon Property is an extraordinary project. It features a beautiful 455 m² Maison de Maître, with the structural work already qualitatively renovated, and composed of large rooms: a 53 m² entrance hall, a living room with a stone fireplace of 37 m², a 26 m² dining room, an office, and sanitary facilities on the ground floor. On the first floor, you'll find the main bedroom of 100 m² with its en-suite bathroom, along with two other bedrooms measuring 34 and 48 m², a bathroom, and a TV area. At the back, and connected to the Maison de Maître, the renovated 185 m²

section includes a kitchen and a large living room, set to become a spacious kitchen with a pantry once the Maison de Maître renovations are complete. Two of the bedrooms have exterior access, as they are designed for guests, and one of them features a kitchenette and a living area with a fireplace insert.

Once the work is completed, the total living space will be 640 m². A lovely terrace with a fountain, beautiful trees in the garden, and views of the countryside add a romantic touch to the property.

A 90 m² garage for three cars, an easily accessible attic for storage, and a boiler room complete the house.

The advantage of this property: you can finish the Maison de Maître to your taste while living comfortably in the renovated section.
