Ideal for all family or professional projects, this farm house is full of charm and has been partially renovated. The ground floor is composed of a big and very bright living room (36 m²) with a fitted kitchenette, a sitting

room (34 m²) with an open fireplace, a bedroom (23 m²) and a recent shower-room (+10 m², with walk-in shower).

Upstairs there are three bedrooms (16 m², 17 m² & 22 m²), a bathroom and an attic (+80 m²) that can be converted into more living spaces.

You'll also enjoy outbuildings (cowshed, workshop) and a well, all on a flat plot of land (+4 hectares) that is planted with trees (apple, fig, peach).

The roof of the main outbuilding has been partly overhauled.

Wood-burning heating and the living room has an A/C system.

Electric hot-water heater (200L).

Joinery is wooden and single-glazed.

Drainage connected to a septic tank.

Located 15 minutes from Masseube and from Boulogne-sur-Gesse; 25 min from Lannemezan; 1 hr 20 min from the airport in Toulouse.

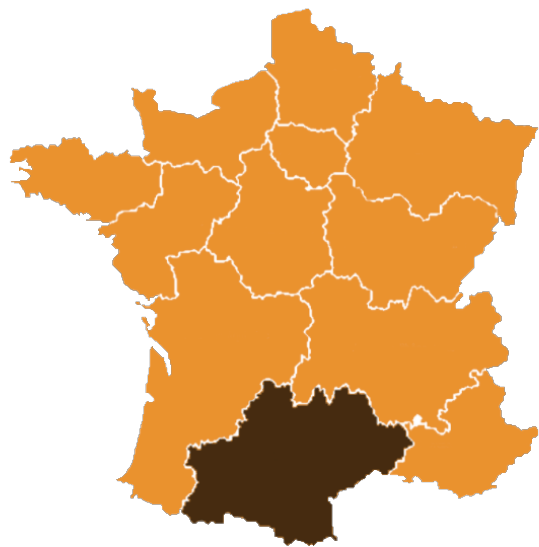
