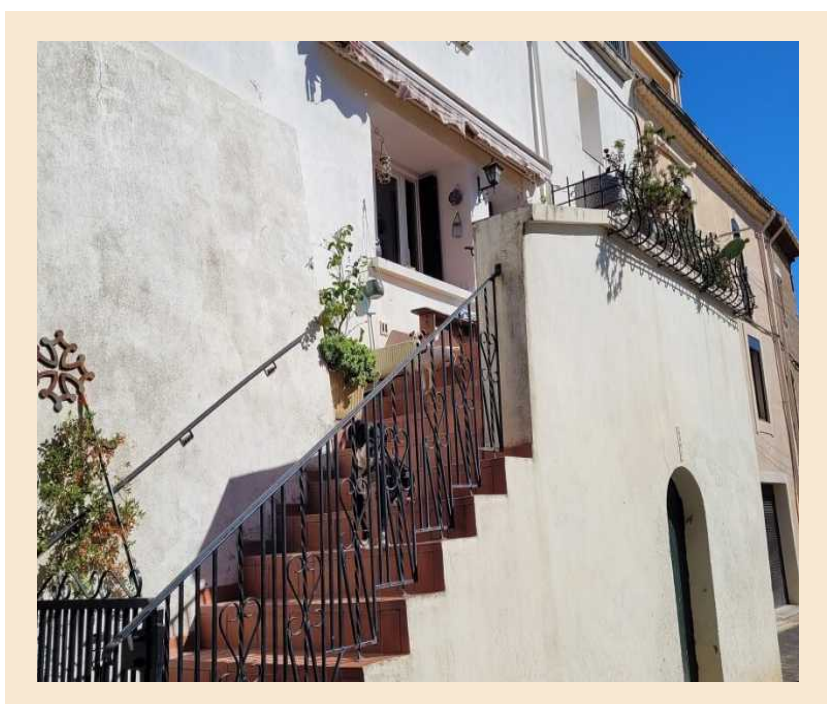

### Property Description

bathrooms, a 10 m<sup>2</sup> terrace and a 23 m<sup>2</sup> roof terrace with stunning views, plus a garage. Located in the heart of the village, 2 minutes from all shops.

Ground = Detached 20 m<sup>2</sup> garage + 6 m<sup>2</sup> utility room + 15 m<sup>2</sup> cellar with access to the rear of the property.

Miscellaneous = Electric heating and reversible air conditioning in the living room on 1st floor + estimated amount of annual energy consumption for standard use: between 1795 € and 2429 € per year. 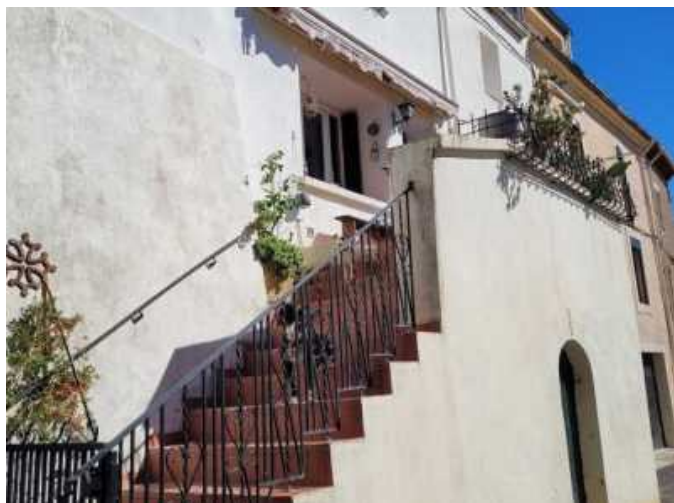
