#### **Property Description**

This magnificent 17th-century townhouse perfectly blends historical charm and modern living in the heart of the Tarn area of the Occitanie region. With a spacious 540 sq.m of living area spread across three levels, this property features a beautiful garden bordered by a large terrace and a double parking space. All shops and amenities in walking distance, including *boulangerie*, shops, butcher, *cafés*, restaurants, chemist, a small

supermarket and weekly market.

*The ground floor* boasts a workshop or garage, a summer kitchen in an independent workshop, and several entrances, including an elegant classic entrance with wood paneling and beautiful cement tiles. The most commonly used entrance is through the kitchen, providing direct access to the terrace.

The grand living room is a showstopper with an impressive ceiling height of almost 7 meters, featuring a monumental brick fireplace, herringbone parquet flooring, and well-preserved period windows. The elegant dining room, adorned with Versailles parquet and two integrated cupboards, leads to a magnificent reception room overlooking the courtyard. This room features a marble fireplace, herringbone hardwood floor, molded wood paneling, and a golden rosette, creating a soft and refined atmosphere. A small vestibule offers another access to the terrace, while the fully equipped kitchen opens directly onto the terrace, complete with an adjacent utility room. The ground floor includes several independent toilets, a laundry room, and washbasins.

*On the first floor*, you'll find four stunning master bedrooms, each blending historical charm with modern comfort. Every bedroom has its bathroom, ante-chamber, or boudoir, ensuring privacy and luxury. One of the suites adjoins another room, perfect for a living room or a child's bedroom.

*The second floor* features a master suite with an ante-chamber, bathroom, and office and a vast room serving as a combined office, cinema room, and reading space. Additionally, a spacious room overlooks the city's promenades, offering views of the monuments. A magnificent attic provides access to the tower and the loft.

Finally, the property includes a well with a pump and several beautifully maintained cellars, offering excellent storage space. This townhouse is a true gem, combining the elegance of the past with the comforts and convenience of modern living.




















