Located in Lavaur, this 250 sqm character house is located in the heart of a 6-hectare estate, offering a peaceful setting without neighbors. Between generous volumes, authentic materials and omnipresent light, it combines charm and functionality. The entrance is through the independent kitchen, heated by a wood stove. Two large living rooms totaling 77 sqm reveal a beautiful high ceiling, enhanced by exposed beams, fairground bricks and a through fireplace. The open staircase brings a unique touch to this bright space. This level also has a room to be fitted out according to needs, an office, a shower room with WC, a laundry room

and a garage of almost 100 sqm. Upstairs, two bedrooms with beautiful volumes each have their own shower room or bathroom with WC. The top level offers a bedroom, a bathroom and a multi-purpose space, ideal as a spare bedroom or games room. Outside, a lean-to and a 25 sqm room complete the outbuildings. The swimming pool blends harmoniously into the environment and benefits from an unobstructed view of the surrounding nature. 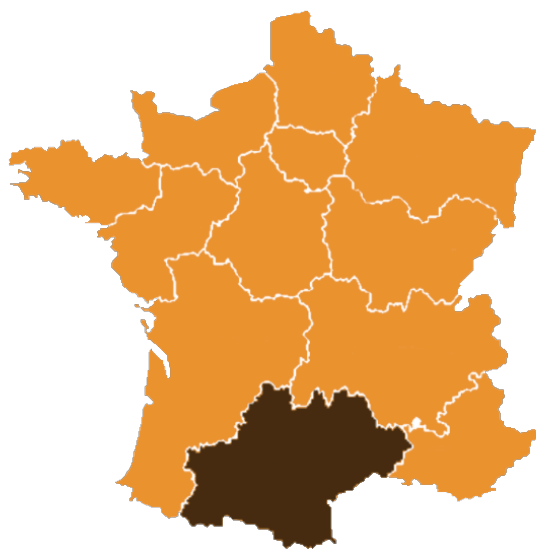

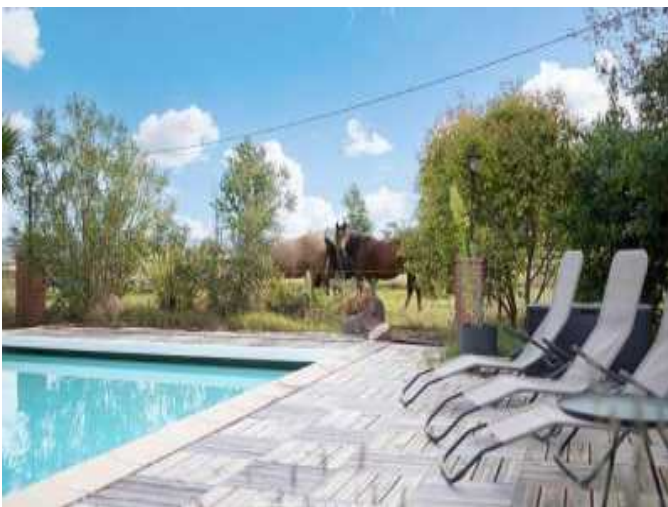
