Property Description

Nestled at the back of the plot, out of sight and a few steps from the popular Minimes district, this 182 sqm architect-designed house is the result of a bold restructuring of two buildings from the early 20th century. Designed in 2007 with an eco-responsible approach, it combines optimal comfort and energy efficiency. From the entrance, the natural light and volumes are striking. The 70 sqm living space is fascinating. It

consists of a living-dining room and an open kitchen combining modernity and conviviality. The large bay windows offer a fluid connection with the outside, overlooking an incredible landscaped garden. It is naturally extended by a second room that can meet various needs: office, gym, library. Adjoining this living space, an additional room can be adapted to your needs: office, gym or library. A hallway leads to a first spacious and bright bedroom as well as a bathroom. A laundry area and a separate toilet complete this level. The floors are dedicated to rest. On the first floor, a second bathroom with toilet separates two bright bedrooms. One of them offers access to a terrace and its vegetable garden. The second and last floor serves the fourth bedroom overlooking the garden. All the bedrooms; as well as the living room, are equipped with custom-made fitted cupboards. The outdoor space has been entirely landscaped and designed to offer an island of freshness. Its terrace, in the center of the garden, is a true haven of peace.
