### Property Description

Minervois village with all amenities (cafe, restaurant, bakery:) located 5 minutes from Lac de Jouarres, 10 minutes from Olonzac and 35 minutes from Narbonne.

Charming bourgeoise house, 2 sides, dating from the 18th century, this building offers large areas with lots of

potential ! In total almost 600 m<sup>2</sup> with several annexes to renovate if required, according to taste and desires. Main house of 274 m<sup>2</sup> that has been completely renovated, including 5 bedrooms (one master bedroom), 3 shower rooms, several lounges, a dining room and a kitchen. There is also a large convertible attic space with several rooms, with a total surface area of about 140 m<sup>2</sup>. There are also several outbuildings, a garage of 50 m<sup>2</sup> and a pleasant 240 m<sup>2</sup> courtyard with an above-ground heated swimming pool. A great project, ideal for creating a bed and breakfast.

1st = Magnificent stone staircase leading to a 6 m<sup>2</sup> hallway + 12 m<sup>2</sup> hall + 20.46 m<sup>2</sup> bedroom with fitted wardrobes and decorative fireplace + 12.31 m<sup>2</sup> bedroom + 1.32 m<sup>2</sup> WC + 12 m<sup>2</sup> hall with large fitted wardrobes + 6.84 m<sup>2</sup> shower room (shower, double washbasin unit, heated towel rail) + bedroom of 13.01 m<sup>2</sup> + bedroom of 17.53 m<sup>2</sup> (decorative fireplace) + hall of 3.30 m<sup>2</sup> + dressing room of 4 m<sup>2</sup> + master suite of 22.73 m<sup>2</sup> comprising a bedroom of 15.10 m<sup>2</sup> with decorative fireplace and its en suite shower room of 7.63 m<sup>2</sup> (vanity unit, shower, WC, heated towel rail).

2nd = Hall of 6 m<sup>2</sup> + convertible attic of almost 140 m<sup>2</sup> with several rooms.

Outbuildings of 120 m<sup>2</sup> = Former barn on 2 levels + garage of 50 m<sup>2</sup> (for 2 cars).

Exterior = A 240 m<sup>2</sup> courtyard with above-ground swimming pool (chlorine with heat pump, 7×3.5m) + well with pump.

Miscellaneous = Character features such as ceiling mouldings, marble fireplaces, old original staircase + completely renovated + high ceilings + PVC double glazing + wooden shutters + electric heating + reversible air conditioning + roof redone in 2016 + connected to mains drainage + estimated amount of annual energy consumption for standard use: between 1940 € and 2680 € per year.
