This property consists of a house divided into 2 apartments, a 4 bedroom gîte, a large shepherd's hut which sleeps 3 people and a seminar room, perfect for yoga or dance etc. All of this is set on 8894m² of land which includes a permaculture vegetable garden and woodland. With solar panels and an excellent energy rating,

this property is perfect for nature lovers.

House 1:

Apartment 1 (95m2):

Built surrounded in nature, this wooden house has recently been renovated and comes with the WOW factor. With a made to measure kitchen, wall to ceiling windows overlooking the stunning scenery and a beautiful log burner that heats the whole property. Above the open plan living/kitchen area, there is a mezzanine space which would be perfect for an office. In addition, there are two bedrooms, two shower rooms and a utility space. Off the living space, there is access to terraces that wrap around the property, enabling you to immerse yourself in nature and find a spot in the sun or shade, any time of the day.

Apartment (50m2):

Newly built, open plan apartment with made to measure kitchen, French doors onto the terrace, dressing area, and large shower room.

Gite (82m2):

Wooden chalet which sleeps 9 people, with 4 bedrooms, 2 shower rooms, large living/kitchen space and numerous terraces, which propel you into nature.

Roulotte:

Large shepherd's hut which sleep 3 with shower room, kitchen and private outside terrace.
