Property Description

For sale in the southern region of France, in Occitanie, is this rare domain consisting of a historical French château with a 400 hectare estate fit for kings, located near Pont du Gard. The estate includes a famous castle which hosted many historical figures over the centuries since its construction. Charles IX and Catherine de Medici, Richelieu and King Louis XIII are among the notable figures who have stayed on this property.

The stone castle, which measures 1676 sqm, consists of two adjoining wings and a residential building known as "the Fortified Templar Farm". Additionally, on another part of the estate is the Magnanerie, which includes a residential building called "the former farm", a mill and its bief, an 18th century chapel entirely painted by Georges Desvallières, a cellar and its abandoned cellars, a cooler, a small chapel near the Gardon, bread-oven, greenhouses, orangery, swimming pool, catacombs and beautiful French gardens.

This unique Domaine is ideally located just 30 minutes from major cultural cities such as Nimes and Avignon, one hour from Marseille Marignane airport, and one hour from the TGV station of Aix-en-Provence which makes Paris just a short two-hour train ride away.




