

Property Description

This pleasant former winegrower property is situated in a medieval village of the Corbières between Talairan and Laroque de Fa, villages with small shops. More amenities and shopping can be found at Lézignan (30 minutes), then Carcassonne and Narbonne for large supermarkets and the international airport (50 minutes).

The property comes with approx. 3 acres of land and consists of the main winegrower house of 147 sq.m; a house for "grape pickers" (51.60 sq.m), an open summer kitchen with a barbecue of 15 sq.m, an enclosed summer kitchen of 24 sq.m, an old wine cellar garage with 2 tanks of 40.6 sq.m, a garage/workshop for two cars of 38 sq.m;, two sheds with exploitable mezzanine 38/60 sq.m;, a workshop of 50 sq.m; and a swimming pool to renovate (10m X 5m).
