The land is divided into 3 distinct parts in order to offer both pleasure and functionality: an adorable little tree-lined courtyard leads to a gate on the street for easy access when returning from foot races, a beautiful paved esplanade is reserved for access cars and parking, and finally an adorable priest's

garden faces the house and offers unusual access to a pretty vaulted cellar. The house has several levels and half-levels, which gives it a real character. On the garden level, a large entrance leads to a guest toilet, a large laundry room and a pleasant fitted kitchen with dining area, which makes it a living room in its own right. Another level reveals a double living room of approximately 50 m2, crossing light with its triple orientation, which is presented in 2 open parts: a beautiful dining area, then a pleasant cathedral living room slightly raised by a few steps. A cathedral veranda completes the living spaces and fills the need for an office, workshop or games room. A few steps higher, it is the parental space which is structured around a landing with cupboard, offering a bedroom and a large bathroom with shower and bathtub and a toilet. Above we discover two other spacious and bright bedrooms, under cathedral attic spaces, ideal for accommodating children's space. Finally, to complete this set, there are added 2 garages of 27 m² each, 3 cellars and 1 workshop. 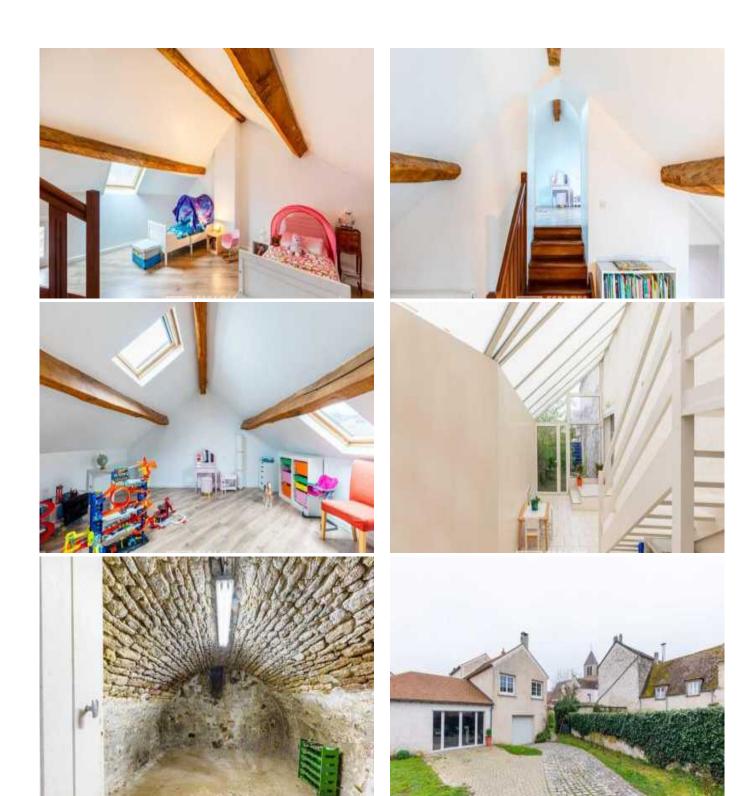
