The entrance is made after a flight of steps, at the rear of the house, which opens onto the superb living room with a beautiful ceiling height of 3 m, and the dining room which totals 42 sqm on a beautiful parquet floor. , a fireplace, and a superb old spiral staircase which provides access to an office/bedroom with small attic on the first floor.

The kitchen is separated from this large living room by a double door made of wood and glass tiles. A first bedroom of 11 sqm is located near the living room, the second of 10.50 sqm is accessible via a hallway which also serves the bathroom. A full basement consists of a large storage room/games room, a laundry room and a technical room. This property benefits from several outbuildings which can be transformed into a small dwelling, workshops, covered terraces or storage rooms. This pretty old house benefits from an exceptional view of the Seine, not overlooked, surrounded by its bucolic garden on a plot of more than 1,600 sqm. 
