Nestled in its green setting at the edge of the pedestrian paths, this house with an atypical plan was built in the 70s with many codes of charm and the old. An entrance with cupboards serves different living spaces on the ground floor: a fitted and equipped kitchen redone in 2019 and which opens onto a pleasant rear terrace. Semi-open, it also opens onto a cathedral living room bathed in light through its numerous openings and

equipped with a pellet stove which provides significant energy comfort. Then, an office equipped with large cupboards leads to a veranda which overlooks the garden, and makes it a perfect reception room for moments of sharing with family or friends. Finally, a bedroom with cupboards, a shower room and toilets complete the ground floor. The first level reveals a pleasant TV lounge on the mezzanine with numerous storage cupboards, which leads to a master suite with lots of character! Indeed, old beams, terracotta tiles and a view of the village bell tower make it a timeless space. The room is divided into several spaces with a large spa bathroom and access to what the current owners call their eagle's nest, a converted attic which can accommodate storage or a play area for the little ones. Finally, above the garage a bedroom has been fitted out with a shower and toilet which communicates with the whole but can also have its own independent access. An adjoining garage allows you to bring in a vehicle, and a small outbuilding of around 12 m² can easily accommodate tools and outdoor furniture. The enclosed, wooded garden of 923 m2 offers numerous relaxation areas in full sun or sheltered by large trees which provide shaded rest areas. 


