A ground floor serves an entrance, a large office of 25m2 (with kitchenette), ideal for a liberal profession or

teleworking, and an independent studio, perfect for a young girl with a father or rental profitability.

From the entrance, a door opens onto a staircase, the true backbone of the house, which leads to a beautiful, warm living room on the first floor. It has a lounge area and a dining area which give pride of place to a library across the entire width of the room.

A large open kitchen conducive to discussion makes it easy to plan with family or friends. Still on the same level, a large bedroom with three windows, a bathroom and a separate toilet will be ideal for the parents' space.

Continuing from the reception, the staircase leads to the second floor, three attic bedrooms (including a small one), as well as a shower room with toilet.

A little secret preserved from the outside, a glass door gives access to a small tree-lined terrace (10m²) hidden from view, and ideal for intimate evenings.

Finally, from the office located on the ground floor, a staircase leads to a converted basement leading to a main room that can be converted into a home cinema, or a games room, and two storage rooms.
