Located in the heart of Parc Montaigne, close to amenities, this modern apartment bathed in light is located on the fourth and top floor of a pleasant co-ownership from the end of the 1960s, renovated, in the middle of greenery and in a quiet area. The surface area of this apartment is 98 sqm including an 8 sqm loggia which provides a lot of light to the living room. Access to the floors is via an entrance hall doubly secured by

intercom allowing you to use either the modern design elevator or the wide marble staircase. Past the front door of the apartment, a corridor/clearance serves on the left the beautiful and bright, very well appointed independent kitchen (10 sqm) as well as the SOUTH/WEST facing living room of 30 sqm and opposite the sleeping area. A door separates the living area from the sleeping area. Past this, directly on the left is a spacious dressing room, three WEST-facing bedrooms (10, 10 and 12 sqm, one of which has its own dressing room of 2.5 sqm. A bathroom (8 sqm) and WC complete this part of the apartment. The whole is in very good condition and does not require work. All the windows are double glazed and have rolling shutters. A cellar and a private outdoor parking space complete the whole. The co-ownership also offers a huge secure leisure park with huge supervised swimming pool, pool house, tennis courts, mini golf and children's play area. 
