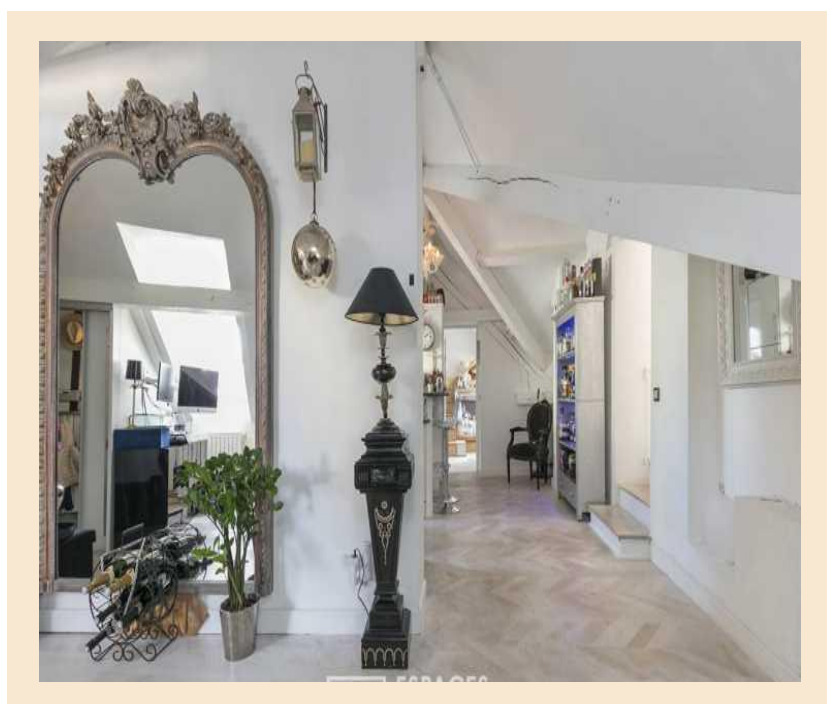

The common part of the building offers a superb three-story old staircase, made of old wood, tiles and ironwork. The entrance with storage space opens onto the elegant

dining room of 12 sqm Carrez, (21 sqm on the floor) to continue with the semi-open kitchen of 18 sqm. The hallway leads to a first bedroom of 13 sqm on the ground as well as a bathroom. Opposite the kitchen, after a flight of steps, the living room, perfectly atypical in its organization, reveals a warm reception room, open on either side with seated dogs which allow a beautiful through light into this room with careful decoration, decorated a pretty fireplace.
