Past a large entrance, the ground floor accommodates a pleasant living room of 35 m2 with large bay windows opening onto a first terrace. A bedroom or office of 13 m2 completes this level. On the first floor, a landing room with plenty of storage space distributes on one side a large dining kitchen with contemporary lines, and on the other a charming 26 m2 terrace surrounded by greenery and out of sight.




