The living room, raised by two steps, has a pretty fireplace with access to the garden. A storage room completes the features of this plateau. The staircase leads to the first level, which consists of a large landing, a bedroom, an office space

and a bathroom. The top floor is organized into two bedrooms, a dressing room and a shower room. The house has an outbuilding which consists of a laundry room, a workshop and a bedroom. The pleasant bucolic garden, enclosed and not overlooked, offers flowers and apple trees around the garden table where it is good to meet for a barbecue. This house, quiet, close to schools, the medical center and small village shops, can still evolve in its organization. It is ideal for the family who will know how to invest in this charming place. 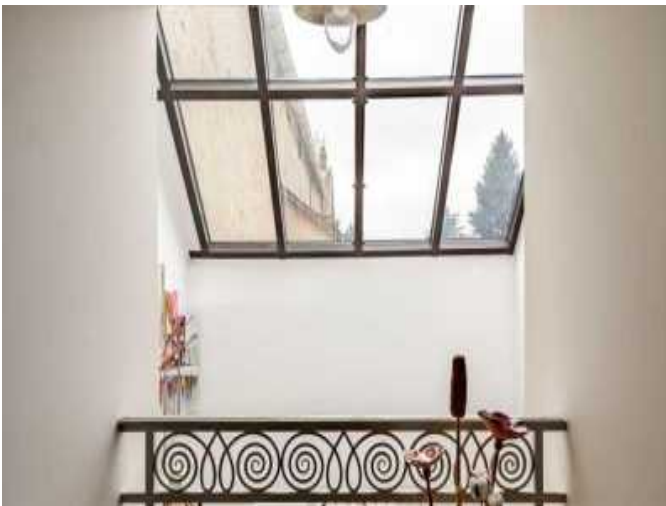
