1900 and comes from the Paris World's Fair. This studio with its extraordinary volume is the result of a colossal and unique renovation.

The property opens onto an entrance with storage and a first bathroom with WC on the right.

The corridor has been restructured to accommodate a pleasant equipped kitchen on either side. It is extended by the dining room and its pretty fireplace. Adjoining this space is the first bedroom.

A true architectural product, the impressive 56m2 living room stands out at the back of the studio, benefiting from a ceiling height of 6m, and a large glass roof providing constant light to the whole in double North-West exposure. It is completed by a large 4m2 balcony as well as a spectacular custom-made piece of furniture to enhance this space.

A staircase provides access to the upper floor and allows you to enjoy the view. It is clear, green and calm. You can also see the Eiffel Tower or hear the birds singing on the green belt.
