Nestled in a green setting of 1,100 sqm, in the residential district of Thiers, this unique property, built in 1972, offers 405 sqm on three levels. Surrounded by a landscaped park and decorated with a remarkable beech tree, this property combines volume, brightness and a peaceful setting. A heated indoor swimming pool of 9 mx 3.5 m and a pool house complete this rare ensemble.

Upon entering, a 38 sqm hall, combining a relaxation area and a bar, sets the tone for a house designed for conviviality. This level reveals a triple living room of 50 sqm bathed in light, an independent studio, an office, a dressing room as well as a boiler room/laundry room and a cellar.

Each space has been designed to combine functionality and comfort.

A marble staircase, enhanced by a wrought iron banister, leads to the first floor.

This one is distinguished by a bright reception room of 50 sqm, extended by a kitchen-diner and a pantry. The whole, facing South-West, opens onto a balcony surrounding the floor and offering a clear view of the park.

The night space includes a master suite of 40 sqm with dressing room, bathroom and a separate toilet, as well as a second space composed of two bedrooms, a shower room and a bathroom with toilet, accessible via a corridor decorated with built-in cupboards.

The second floor completes the house with four bedrooms with beautiful volumes (from 12 to 20 sqm) and a shower room with toilet. A 79 sqm attic with great development potential completes this level.

Outside, the park accommodates at the front a covered parking lot that can easily accommodate three vehicles.

At the back, the heated mosaic swimming pool, surrounded by large bay windows, creates a perfect harmony between interior and exterior. An electric shutter ensures the safety of the pool, while a wooden beach offers a perfect space to install deckchairs.

This villa is a true haven of peace, a stone's throw from shops, schools and transport. Although renovation work is to be expected, its generous volumes, its privileged location and its unique services make it a rare property on the market.
