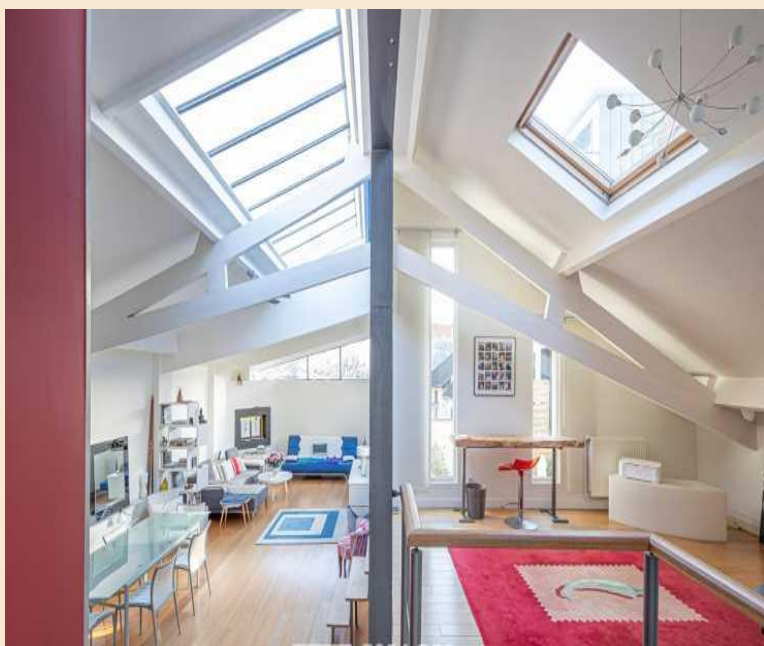

Property Description

In the setting of Fontenay-sous-Bois, this loft with generous volumes has a total surface area of 165 sqm (150 sqm Carrez law), revealing three half-levels and accessible from a private driveway.

The entrance is via a corridor leading to a bedroom which opens onto the terrace, equipped with a dressing room. A bathroom with shower and bathtub as well as a separate toilet complete this first level.

A staircase leads to a living room illuminated by multiple openings and an overhead glass roof. Like a visual poem, this space is set up as an open space, weaving several distinct universes: a cozy living room, a dining area as well as a kitchen shaping this place and benefiting from a southern exposure throughout the day. A scullery-laundry room completes this second level.

At the heart of this living room, a flight of steps leads to the last level composed of a platform evoking a spare bedroom or an office overlooking the interior life, thus connecting the other nocturnal corner of the loft. Two bedrooms, one with its own bathroom, are discovered, accompanied by a separate toilet.

A garage, witness to the co-ownership regime, completes this property.

The private terrace facing south, the different spaces as well as the volumes give this loft a uniqueness on the outskirts of Paris.
