

Property Description

Located on the banks of the Saint-Denis Canal, near the Church and the Saint Denis train station, in a former dried flower warehouse, a 196m2 (180.27m2 Carrez) loft reinvented by an architect.

Sheltered from a courtyard, this renovation organized around a 23m2 patio gives pride of place to concrete in multiple ways and to the omnipresence of light.

The entrance leads to a living room of approximately 70m2 opening on one side to the kitchen delimited by a central island and on the other to the Japanese-inspired patio.

On one side, the parental suite benefits from a custom-made dressing room and a bathroom with shower and bathtub totaling 30m2.

On the other hand, the library cleverly conceals a mezzanine that can be used as an extra bed and provides access to the second living room with a fireplace. As an extension, two other bedrooms each benefiting from a mezzanine share a bathroom with water closet.

A boiler room also serving as a laundry room and a second guest water closet complete the level.

The quality of materials and finishes, the variations of varnished concrete poured in the mass, the many custom-made pieces of furniture are highlighted by a refined and contemporary decoration.
