In a village in the Yvelines less than 1 hour from Paris, this historic castle offers immense potential for heritage and renovation enthusiasts looking for greenery and nature.

The main building offers approximately 350 m2 of living space spread over 4 levels.

On the ground floor, a superb entrance hall leads to a dining room with a monumental fireplace, a large reception room of over 50 m² with large openings overlooking the park, and a small kitchen to be redesigned.

The upper floors are served by spacious landings and currently total 9 very comfortable bedrooms, several bathrooms and an attic to be converted.

Period woodwork, authentic parquet floors and sculpted ceilings bear the history of this residence that is just waiting to be revived.

The semi-buried basement offers many development possibilities with its cellars, workshops and the former servants' kitchen.

The park of more than 3.5 hectares offers a bucolic and exceptional setting with its lime tree avenue classified as a Historic Monument. There is a tennis court to renovate, a gazebo sheltered from view which makes a real observation post to contemplate the park throughout the seasons.

Finally, the property has 400 m2 of outbuildings to restore, spread around the castle: caretaker's house divided into several parts, garages, sheepfold, stables, and dovecote.


