Property Description

Located on the second floor of the Hôtel des Enfants de Madame de Montespan, a magnificent 17th century building transformed into a convent in the 19th century and recently renovated, this atypical duplex with generous volumes offers 93 m2 Carrez (140 m2 on the ground). It is completed by a pleasant terrace overlooking the wooded park of the condominium.

The entrance opens onto a large living room bathed in light, enhanced by a beautiful high ceiling. The kitchen open to the living room invites conviviality, while a mezzanine, ideal for an office, overlooks the whole. This first level also includes a bedroom opening onto the terrace, offering absolute calm facing the park of the condominium.

The upper floor offers two large attic bedrooms of more than 25 m² on the ground with an authentic character with their exposed framework, as well as a bathroom.

A large 80 m² cellar and a parking space for rent in the courtyard of the condominium (euros50/month) complete the services of this family apartment nestled in this building full of history.

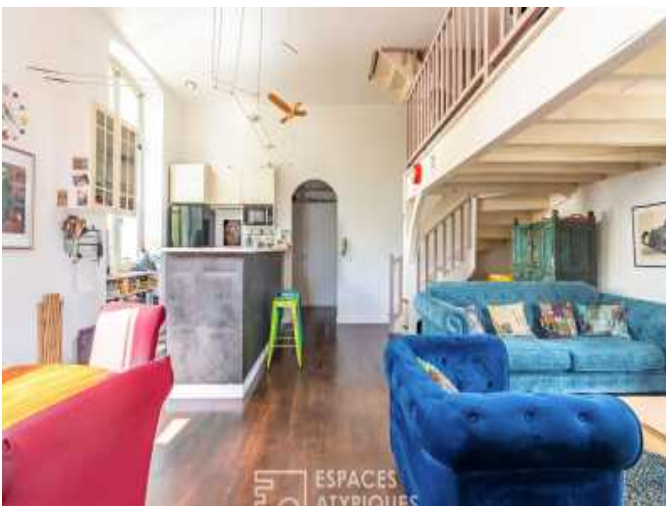
