Rare and unique property from a famous modernist / avant-garde architect ideally located just 15 minutes from the heart of Paris. Needs renovation.

The house was built in 1954 by the famous architect Claude Parent (1923-2016). Built on stilts, it benefits

from a large sunny living room, 3 bedrooms, kitchen, bathroom.

The current owners have closed the space in between stilts to create 2 further bedrooms and a laundry room. The property could easily be converted into 2 apartments, one on the ground floor, the other on the 1st floor).

Outside, there's enough space to create a winter garden / summer kitchen / living space thanks to the glass front overlooking the entrance.

The plot of 900 sq.m means a 2nd house can be built and/or extra equipment (swimming pool, garden shed, extra building, etc.).

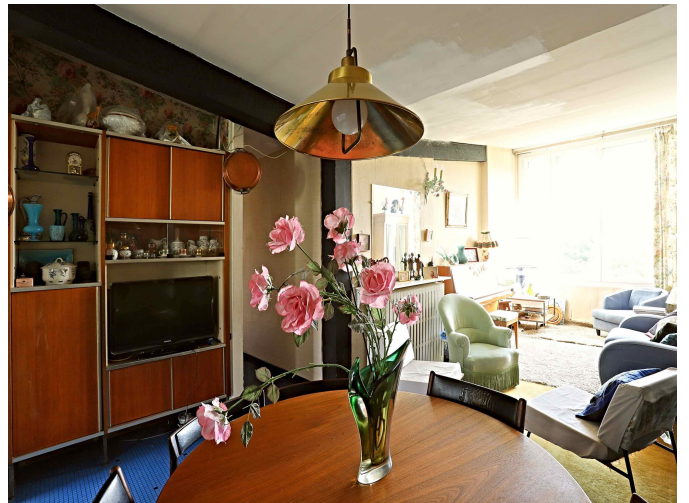

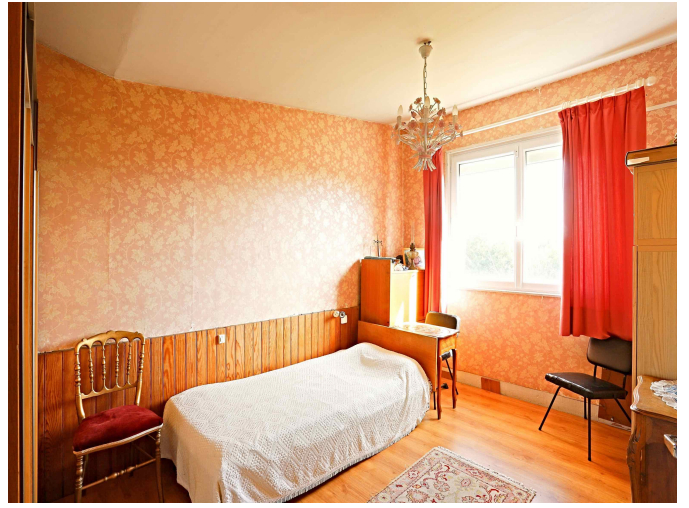
