Imprinted by time, it emanates a tranquility preserved in a serene neighborhood. From the half-open gate, the charm, for sure, operates: between the glass roof on the facade of the house and the garden which is revealed, the eyes shine! The raised ground floor on 3 vaulted cellars, is discovered by a staircase sheltered under a glass roof. It distributes an independent office and the main entrance of the house. Family life revolves around a double living room of 36sqm, decorated

with the elegance of an insert fireplace. A dining kitchen, fitted out and equipped (late Paul Bocuse), offers a panorama on a suspended terrace, veiled to caress the sunset, without challenging it. 
